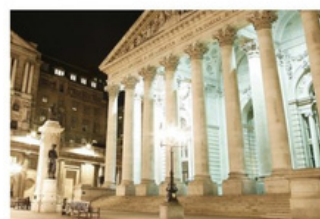
Some examples of how Kingsfleet achieved Silver:

- Office waste is sorted and recycled (all staff members are educated as to which materials can be recycled and collected): shredded paper is added to compost, waste printer toners are recycled in another Claydon Court office, coffee 'pods' are returned to the manufacturer for recycling.
- Introduced DocuSign and an online client portal to remove the need for printing and posting documents.
- Locally sourced stationary and office equipment. FSC certified paper is specified for all on-site paper use.
- Local business are used in preference to those from further afield (local IT, book-keeping, human resources and marketing consultants).
- Better quality goods purchased, despite greater cost (increasing value for money).
- The 'Waterbar' maintains hot water at 60 °C (instead of 92 °C - 96 °C).
- Developed and implemented a sustainable travel policy.
- Distance services are offered to clients to reduce the need for travel.
- Kingsfleet supports a number of ongoing projects which aim to reduce waste/improve environmental management and sustainability (e.g. Yellowfish and Litter-Free Felixstowe).
