Barnwell Print is Norfolk's first Certified Carbon Balanced Publication Printer since 2012. All unavoidable production carbon emissions are offset through the World Land Trust Carbon Balanced Paper programme. **Other environmental actions implemented include:**

- **Premises**

- Installation of biomass heating to replace the original oil-fired heating system.
- Lighting upgraded to low energy equivalents.
- New energy efficient presses installed in 2017 (these have increased output by over 20%).
- Barnwell Print's electricity can be reported as zero-carbon using both "market-based" and "location-based" calculations 100% renewable electricity supplied by E-On.

- **Materials and Suppliers**

- In order to be part of their supply chain all suppliers have to be part of the carbon balancing economy.
- All deliveries are made through a registered carbon neutral logistics firm.
- All paper is 'Carbon Balanced Paper' with emissions offset via the World Land Trust. Inks are vegetable based and not tested on animals.

- **Waste**

- Detailed waste audits of all key materials to minimise waste, with over 90% of waste recycled.

- **Staff and Awareness**

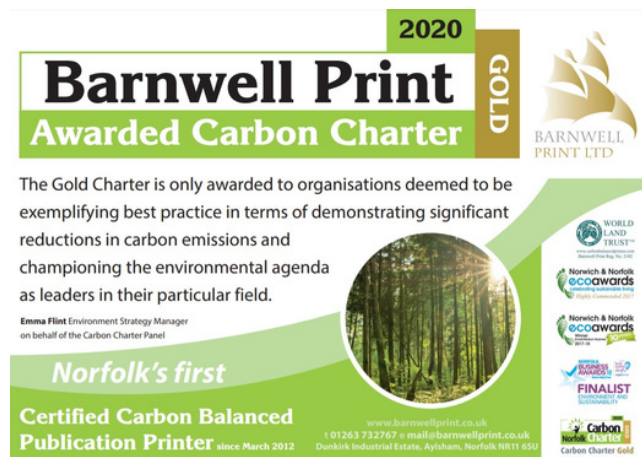
- Communicates effectively on environmental issues to clients and suppliers, as well as wider sphere of influence.
- Staff are encouraged to cycle and use public transport with high staff awareness for the companies environmental ethos.
