Surplush earn Carbon Charter Bronze Award

Surplush focuses on supplying their customers with the highest quality, locally sourced groceries delivered right to their door. Their core values are to operate in an environmentally conscious manner, be sustainable and to support local British suppliers.

How Surplush achieved Bronze:

- **Premises and Waste**
 - Waste is separated and recycled.
 - Food waste is composted.
- **Supply Chain and Delivery:**
 - Products are supplied purely by companies in and around Norfolk, with the majority of these being within Norwich. This massively reduces the carbon footprint of their supply chain and food miles.
 - Has a products page for Vegan goods.
 - Orders are delivered using an e-cargo 100% electric bike, minimising the congestion and carbon emissions the business is responsible for.
 - Customers are offered the choice to loan tupperware which eliminates the need for packaging in delivery.
- **Management and Policy:**
 - Surplush have calculated and monitored their carbon footprint.
 - They have published an Environmental Policy with clear aims and future goals.
- **Staff and Community Outreach:**
 - Environmentalism and sustainability is a key theme throughout their website.
 - It is in Surplush's Environmental Policy to promote sustainability to their staff, suppliers and individuals within their local community.
