Energy Efficiency Recommendations

- ✓ Using HVO for your remaining diesel fleet could save 559tCO₂e, or if you switch 10 diesel vans to EVs you could save 75tCO₂e per year
- ✓ A new build strategy for the Lowestoft and Ufford depots could save up to 119.5tCO₂e per year
- ✓ A solar PV array at the Lowestoft depot could save 45.2tCO₂e
- ✓ Encouraging staff and visitors to be mindful of their use of energy and water on-site could lead to a further 5% utilities saving
