Orwell Housing Association received a free carbon footprint and a net zero report by Groundwork East, funded by Suffolk County Council.

Orwell Housing Association manages over 4,300 homes for 8,200 people in 12 local authority areas, and also provides care and support services. Orwell requested support from Groundwork East to update their carbon footprint and obtain advice on decarbonising their premises and business travel.

Energy Efficiency Recommendations

- ✓ New build programme to include 180 heat pumps over the next 3 years and is estimated to save 179tCO₂e
- ✓ Installing an additional 200 domestic solar PV arrays over the next 2-3 years is estimated to save 138tCO₂e per year
- ✓ Replacing old storage heaters with modern Quantum storage heaters will save 15.3tCO₂e per 100 heaters per year
- ✓ Reduce office emissions by 10% over 2 years to save 6.7tCO₂e per year
