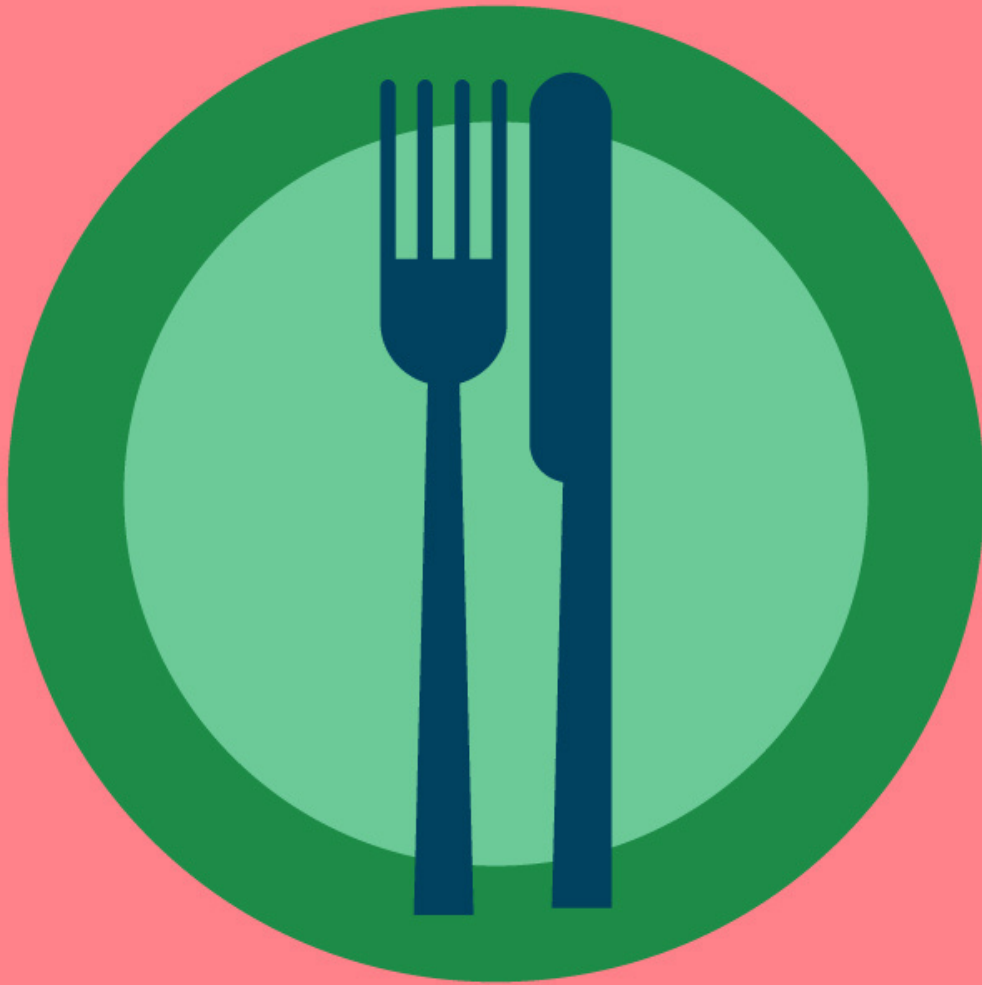

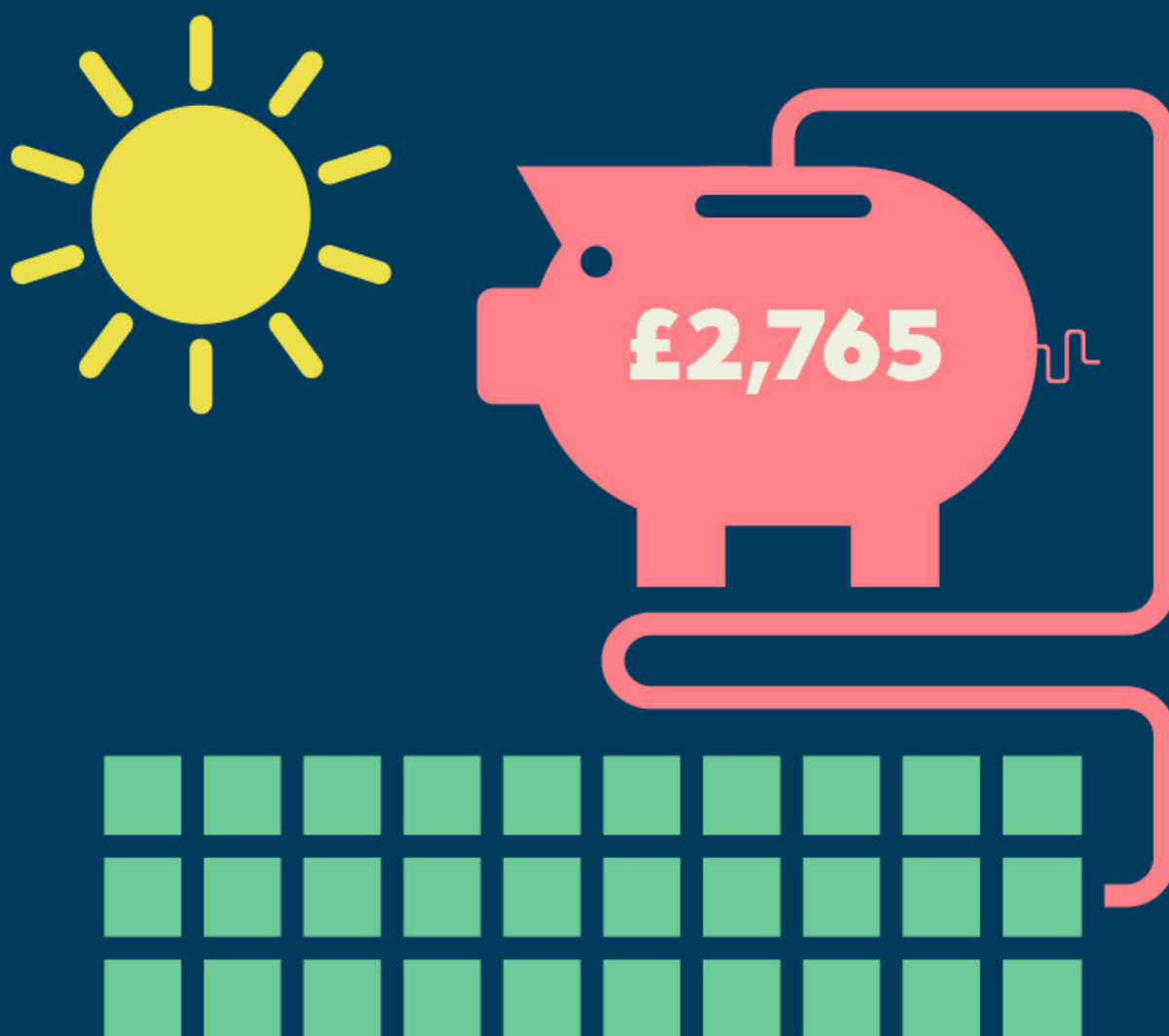

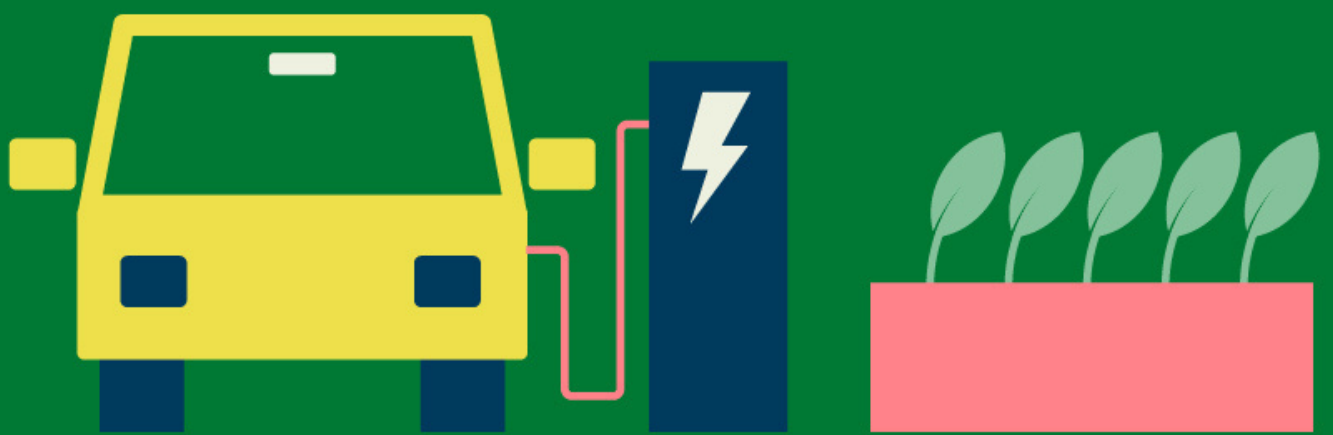
First Steps
